

Policy Statement

As an organisation, Axis Trampoline & Gymnastics Club believes that no child should experience abuse or harm. As such, Axis Trampoline & Gymnastics Club is committed to ensuring that those working with children and vulnerable adults adopt the best possible practices to ensure the health, safety and welfare of all participants and staff.

Axis Trampoline & Gymnastics Club will endeavour to promote the highest standards of care for all members, staff, volunteers and officials by:

1. The adoption of British Gymnastics Health, Safety and Welfare guidelines.
2. The adoption of British Gymnastics guidelines for the protection of children and vulnerable adults.
3. The appointment of a Welfare Officer to whom grievances or complaints can be made confidentially.
4. Ensuring that coaches, officials and staff have been screened to confirm their suitability to work with children. This will include criminal record check through Disclosure & Barring Service where appropriate.
5. Ensuring that the best coaching practice guidelines are followed at all times.
6. Ensuring that grievances or complaints are dealt with promptly and in accordance with the grievance procedure.
7. Ensuring that there is a minimum of two responsible adults at all training sessions.
8. Ensuring that the participants and parents are aware of the purposes of videoing, filming or photography during training or events.
9. Having a zero tolerance level of poor practice, bullying or any other potential form of abuse.
